

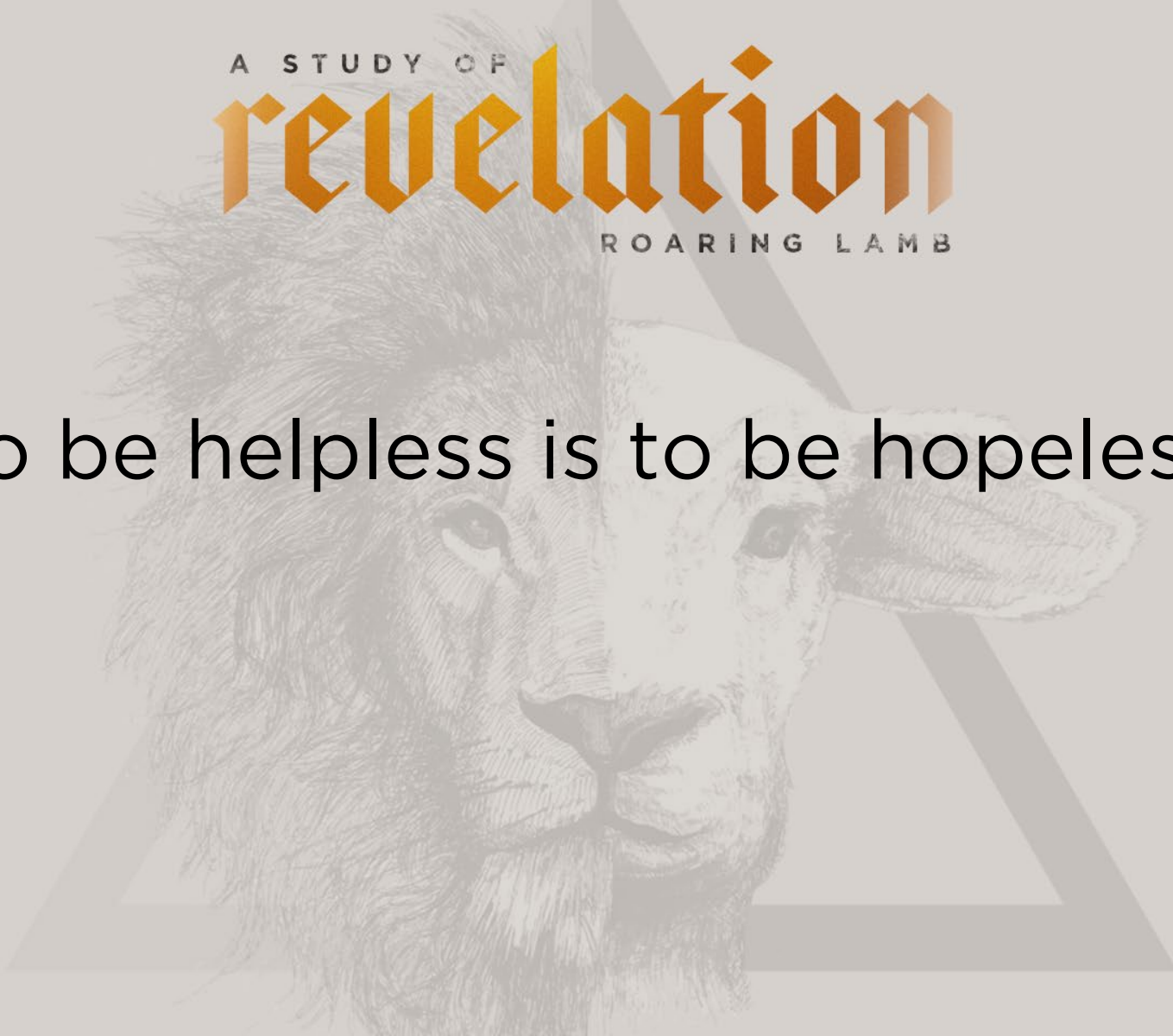




The 'dilemma' (what causes John to weep) is that no one was found worthy to open the scroll or to read its contents.


