GLOBAL PARTNER OF THE WEEK Sara Hewitt

Sara works under One Challenge in Sofia, Bulgaria, using her doctoral training to publish and serve as a researcher and consultant to pastors, church planters, missionaries and other leaders. She works with a Navigators ministry called Discipling for Development (and helps translate the curriculum into Bulgarian). Sara shared at a Missions luncheon at GracePoint, highlighting the openness to the Gospel of the Roma minority in Bulgaria (known in many places as Gypsics), but also of the cultural challenges of ministering to this group. About 160 Roma church



leaders have participated in D4D training, which focuses on transforming neighborhoods through kingdom-centered community development. Sara and her Bulgarian coworker, Raina, work closely with 3 churches in eastern Bulgaria. Pray for this initiative, and for a society that is struggling with hopelessness, due to a lack of opportunity. Pray for endurance for Sara, Raina, and other leaders, as transformation of communities takes years. Pray for a new agricultural initiative they have started, and for fruitful research projects. Praise that vigorous activism was effective in turning back repressive parliamentary attacks on religious freedom and human rights in Bulgaria. Praise that Sara has found some quality and reliable medical care.
