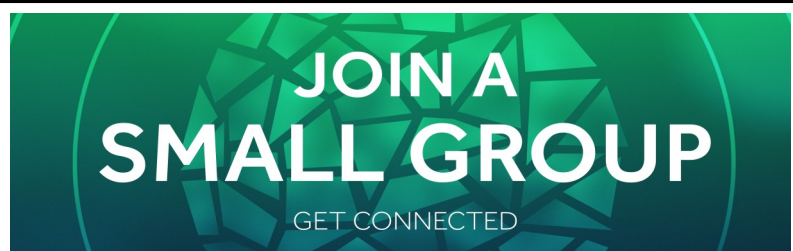

Jeff and Sandy Hagen

Jeff leads Hill Cities' groups, which are 22-month programs focused on discipleship and leadership for men. Many statistics indicate that men in our culture our struggling. For example, incarceration is 90% male. Hill Cities' mission is to relevantly engage men with the truth claims of Jesus Christ. They believe men are searching for significance and seek a brotherhood of men on the same journey. Hill Cities provides this opportunity through the use of cohorts. Jeff writes: "We now have 5 groups of men who are weekly engaged in this ministry. Our vision is to see these men enter their spheres of influence in the marketplace with spiritual light, strength and conviction to make a difference for Christ’s Kingdom." Hill Cities is writing curriculum for small group discipleship based on the book of Romans. The focus is to build Godly conviction that directs men's lives. Jeff has formed a Strategic Partnership with Ambassadors for Business, a Christian Professional Business Networking Organization. This relationship allows Hill Cities to be connected with and interacting with a lot more business people, and to leverage the gift of connecting. Last May, GracePoint men had an opportunity to hear Jeff's vision for men to live transformed lives.
