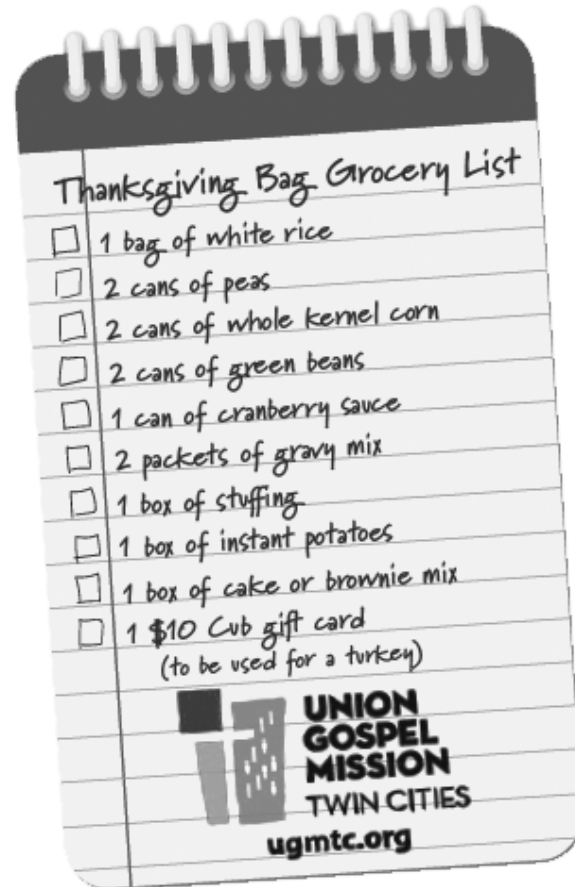

The Chapmans are missionaries in Japan with Converge Worldwide. Jeff and Barb have been developing outreach ministries with Keihanna Christ Church to reach the local community. They write: "Our ministries include, but are not limited to, preaching, leading Bible studies in English and Japanese, youth mentoring, adult discipleship, and outreach to all ages." They also provide leadership in wider church planting and evangelization efforts in Japan, including vision festa, a Japanese-led initiative to plant 50,000 churches in the next decade! That is a God-sized vision! Jeff said there is a strong need for church planters. They have leadership roles on the Converge Japan field as well.
