What happens at Diner Church?

While we eat, one of Vine's pastors/leaders will share a brief scripture/thought and invite the table to conversation. You can engage as much or as little as you would like. Communion is offered and we pray together.

Do we pay for our own meal?

Yes. The Vine provides some appetizers – but otherwise each guest orders from Silver Diner's extensive menu and manages their own check. (Can't afford dinner? Let the pastor know. We can help.)
