Why?

• ALL NATURE testifies to this TRUTH:

- We sow (give) a single seed;
- We reap more seeds
 - Fruitfulness
 - Multiplication
 - Increase

- **GIVING** is a Principle of His Kingdom:
 - It's a seed sown
 - To reap more seeds
 - In order to bless more people
 - Fruitfulness
 - Multiplication
 - Increase

God gives us the power to get wealth?

TO ESTABLISH HIS COVENANT!!

THE KINGDOM OF GOD IS A KINGOM OF INCREASE!

- Some people <u>reject</u> the Message of Seed, Time, and Harvest:
 - "It is a Message of greed."
 - "I don't believe in a 'prosperity gospel."
 - "There is no such principle in the Message of Grace"
 - "It is wrong to expect from God due to something we give (do)" (performance)

...then **obeyed** His instructions of launching out into the deep and letting down the nets for a catch?

...in proportion to the measure we sow

Sowing and reaping takes time

- Seed, Time, and Harvest cannot be cheated
- There is a "due season" for our harvest

Sowing and reaping takes time

- There is an appointed time when the harvest of our seed is due
- It takes time for every seed to:
 - Germinate
 - Gestate, and
 - Become mature for harvest.

- Seed, Time, and Harvest:
 - Those who:
 - Disagree,
 - Misunderstand, and/or
 - Become impatient

BECOME WEARY AND ABORT THEIR HARVEST



¹"Cast your bread upon the waters, for you will find it after many days."



- Weariness (ekluo):
 - "Relax"
 - Not speaking of totally quitting
 - We <u>must maintain the same</u> intensity over a prolonged period of time.
 - Patience: endurance

- Weariness (ekluo):
 - Only comes over time
 - No one becomes weary instantly

HARDENED HEART

- HARDENED: (Dictionary)
 - Cold
 - Insensitive
 - Unfeeling
 - Unyielding

- God created us to have the ability to shut out any unwanted influences.
 - This is our 'defense mechanism'
 - What was meant for good <u>can</u> work **against** us if misused

A HARDENED HEART

DULLS

OUR ABILITY TO
PERCEIVE AND UNDERSTAND

Faith is <u>not</u> a respecter of persons (law)

The Language of faith: EXPECTATION!

Natural Illustrations:

1. Water Evaporation Cycle

- Water evaporates from ocean and forms clouds
- Clouds rain water back to the earth
- By rivers, water flows back to the ocean

■ If the clouds do not give rain they would not reform the seas — the Cycle would be broken.

Natural Illustrations:

2. Decomposition Cycle

- A Tree falls and decomposes over time
- The tree returns to the earth
- To provide nourishment for new trees.

None of us are to hoard all God gives us and keep it for ourselves – we are to share.

- When we withhold more than we should and fail to give to others:
 - We hurt ourselves
 - We break the cycle

 Only in giving do we maintain the cycle and allow God to refill us.

Ecclesiastes 11:1-6 (NKJV)

4"He who **observes** the wind <u>will not</u> sow, and he who **regards** the clouds <u>will not reap."</u>



 Those who <u>wait</u> for the perfect weather will <u>never</u> sow – thus they will <u>never</u> reap

- There are risks in sowing and reaping
 - If we wait <u>until there are no risks</u> we will never step out.
 - We will never un-tether from the dock.

Ecclesiastes 11:1-6 (NKJV)

5"As you do not know what is the way of the wind, or how the bones grow in the womb of her who is with child, so you do not know the works of God Who makes everything."



- Stop making excuses, just as...
 - Casting your bread on the water will return
 - Rain from clouds will evaporate
 - A fallen tree will decompose

As pastors: Do we trust in the...

...Fear of man? OR

...Word of God?

 Many pastors <u>deprive</u> the people by <u>not</u> encouraging tithes and offerings

- They don't want to
 - Be/appear selfish
 - Promote themselves
 - Teach Law

- The <u>only thing</u> that Paul did <u>not</u> do in the Corinthian church
- That he did in other churches:
 - Was be a financial burden
 - By requesting financial support

PAUL SAID HE WAS WRONG!

- Paul was pleased that the church in Philippi had sent him money...
 - Not because he was full (v. 18)
 - He was content before they gave gifts (v. 11)
 - He knew how it would produce...

FRUIT THAT MAY ABOUND TO THEIR ACCOUNT

- It is important to know:
 - Our giving never leaves our lives
 - It is deposited into our spiritual accounts

- If you want the glory of men
 - Then that is all you will ever receive.

- However, it is biblical to give in private
 - Expecting a reward from God.

 You can <u>cancel out</u> your harvest <u>if</u> your heart is not right.

OUR MOTIVES DO MATTER

God is <u>not</u> after your finances...

GODIS AFTER YOUR HEART!

HYPOCRISY:

 DICTIONARY: "the practice of professing beliefs, feelings, or virtues that one does not hold or possess; falseness."

GREEK: Pretending on stage.

HYPOCRISY:

When we do something <u>pretending</u> to please God when in reality we are playacting.

• Not HYPOCRISY:

- Doing what God wants us to do, <u>OR</u>
- Doing unto others what we want them to do to us (Matthew 7:12)

EVEN THOUGH WE MAY NOT FEEL LIKE IT

• Not HYPOCRISY: (EXAMPLE)

Jesus did not like going to the cross.

Jesus died seeking the welfare and benefit of the world!

THE MOTIVES OF THE HEART

ARE MORE IMPORTANT
THAN OUR ACTIONS

2 Corinthians 9:7 (NKJV)

7"So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver."



Giving (including tithing) should be:

- An act of worship
- Thanksgiving
- Acknowledging God as our Source
- Act of faith
- Act of honor
- Act of humility
- Seed you sow

⁴¹"Now Jesus sat opposite the treasury and saw **how** the people put money into the treasury. And many who were rich put in much."



42"Then one poor widow came and threw in two mites, which make a quadrans."



⁴³"So He called His disciples to Himself and said to them, 'Assuredly, I say to you that this poor widow has put more than all those who have given to the treasury.'"

44"'For they all put in out of their abundance, but she out of her poverty put in all that she had, her whole livelihood."



 mammon will <u>not</u> allow you to give like the widow.

- Jesus watched how people gave.
 - The heart matters
 - Not the amount

God sees our giving

We need to see giving as God sees it.

2 Corinthians 9:7 (NKJV)

⁷"So let each one give **as he purposes in his <u>heart</u>**, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver."



- It is good to give from the **heart**...
 - Cheerfully
 - Bountifully
 - Generously
 - Not reluctantly
 - Not under pressure
 - Not out of debt

2 Corinthians 8:12 (NKJV)

¹²"For <u>if</u> there is first a **willing mind**, it is **accepted** according to what one has, and <u>not</u> according to what he does not have."



 This verse <u>could be turned around</u> and still retain its Truth:

"If there is <u>not</u> a willing mind, then the gift will not be accepted regardless of the amount."

The emphasis is on the motive, not the amount

God is not into debt or deficit giving

He <u>only asks</u> us to give what we have

This is <u>not</u> an excuse...

...to <u>never</u> give <u>OR</u> ...to give <u>only if</u> we have extra

Our tithe should be our first fruits.

Proverbs 3:9-10 (NKJV)

⁹"Honor the Lord with your possessions, and with the first fruits of all your increase:"

Proverbs 3:9-10 (NKJV)

¹⁰"So your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will overflow with new wine."



We give from within our means

 We honor, serve and worship Him from what we do have We should not be foolish, trying to impress God

 God is <u>not</u> looking at the **size** of the gift but the **heart** of the giver God is <u>not</u> after your finances...

GODIS AFTER YOUR HEART!

Do <u>not</u> let anyone ever condemn you into giving

 There is a difference <u>between</u> being taught the Truth <u>and</u> being pressured

- As the pastor of this church:
 - I don't want anyone to ever give out of a 'debt they owe!'
 - But as a seed that they sow!
