Romans 4:9 (NKJV)

Romans 4:13-14 (NKJV)

"For the promise that he would be the heir of the world was not to Abraham or to his seed through the law, but through the righteousness of faith. For if those who are of the law are heirs, faith is made void and the promise made of no effect,"

Romans 4:22-24 (NKJV)

"And therefore 'It was accounted to him for righteousness.' Now it was not written for his sake alone that it was imputed to him, but also for us. It shall be imputed to us, who believe in Him Who raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead,"

Romans 4:25 (NKJV)

"who was delivered up because of our offenses, and was raised because of our justification."

Romans 10:9-10 (NKJV)

"that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation."

Galatians 3:29 (NKJV)

"And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise."

1 John 4:16 (NKJV)

Hebrews 8:12 (NKJV)

Zephaniah 3:5 (NKJV)

"The Lord is righteous in her midst, **He** will do no unrighteousness. Every morning He brings His justice to light; He never fails, but the unjust knows no shame."

2 Peter 1:2-3 (NKJV)
