

Psalm 89:14-16 (KJV)

*“Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; mercy and truth go before your face. **Blessed are the people who know the joyful sound!** They walk, O Lord, in the Light of Your countenance. In Your name they rejoice all day long, and in Your righteousness they are exalted.”*

Leviticus 25:2-3 (NKJV)

“Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: ‘When you come into the land which I give you, then the land shall keep a sabbath to the Lord. Six years you shall sow your field, and six years you shall prune your vineyard, and gather its fruit;’”

Leviticus 25:4-5 (NKJV)

“but in the seventh year there shall be a sabbath of solemn rest for the land, a sabbath to the Lord. You shall neither sow your field nor prune your vineyard. What grows of its own accord of your harvest you shall not reap, nor gather the grapes of your unintended vine, **for it is a year of rest for the land.**”

Leviticus 25:6-7 (NKJV)

“And the sabbath produce of the land shall be food for you: for you, your male and female servants, your hired man, and the stranger who dwells with you, for your livestock and the beasts that are in the land—all its produce shall be for food.”

“And you shall sow in the eighth year, and eat old produce until the ninth year, until its produce comes in, you shall eat of the old harvest.”

Leviticus 25:8 (NKJV)

*“And you shall count seven sabbath of years for yourself, **seven times seven years**; and the time of the seven sabbaths of years shall be to you forty-nine years.”*

Leviticus 25:9 (NKJV)

*“Then you shall cause **the trumpet of the Jubilee to sound** on the tenth day of the seventh month, **on the Day of Atonement** you shall **make the trumpet sound throughout all your land.**”*

Leviticus 25:11-12 (NKJV)

***“That fiftieth year shall be a Jubilee
you you; in it you shall neither sow nor
reap** what grows on its own accord, nor
gather the grapes of your unintended
vine. For it is the Jubilee, it shall be holy
to you; you shall eat its produce from
the field.”*

Leviticus 25:9 (NKJV)
