Romans 6:7-9 (NKJV)

*“For he who died has been freed from sin. **Now if we died with Christ, we believe then we shall also live with Him,** knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him.”*

Romans 6:10-11 (NKJV)

*“For the death He died, He died to sin once for all, but the life He lives, He lives to God. Likewise you also, **reckon yourselves t be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.**”*

Ephesians 4:20-22 (NKJV)

*“But you have not so learned Christ, if indeed you have heard Him and been taught by Him as the Truth is in Jesus: that you **put off**, concerning your former conduct, **the old man** which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts,”*
